Dual Language Advantage



- ▶ English Learners and native English speakers in dual immersion programs do as well or better than their peers in other program models -*Genesee et al., 2006; Thomas & Collier, 2002*
- ▶ Primary language instruction in English Learner programs promotes higher level of reading in English -*Genesee et al., 2006; Thomas and Collier, 2002; Snipes, Soga, & Uro, 2007; August & Shanahan, 2006*
- ▶ Instruction in and of the primary language is more effective than English-only and leads to faster academic growth -*Snipes, Soga, & Uro, 2007; August & Shanahan, 2006*
- ▶ Proficiency in two or more languages enhances educational and cognitive development -*Thomas and Collier, 2002; Snipes, Soga, & Uro, 2007; August & Shanahan, 2006*





5th & 6th Grade Pick-up Route

- Students line up on **sidewalk**, wait for teacher to call them as their transportation arrives.
- **Enter only through 5th Avenue**
 - Take turns entering Sierra Way
 - Display white student placard on dash
- Avoid:
 - Lining up prior to 2:30pm
 - **X** Parking, driving, blocking intersections or driveways on noted streets
 - Using cell phone while driving
- Remember to be Respectful
